The second issue is the posted speed of 30 mph, cars park on both side of the road, young children play near or close to the street and 30 mph is way to fast for a residential road with limited sight lines when cars are parked. The other day a speeding car went up on the sidewalk and hit a fire hydrant sending it into the neighbors yard. My children live on this road with my very young grandchildren, we walk this street every day with them and the onslaught of speeding cars needs to be addressed before someone is killed.
