LICENSING BOARD MINUTES May 26, 2021 6:00 p.m. (Remote Meeting)

Licensing Board Members Present: Chairman Dave Wood and Tom Dion

Request from Flamingo Market Corporation d/b/a Attleboro Convenience, 850 Washington Street, for a Change of Officers/Directors/LLC Managers, Issuance/Transfer of Stock/New Stockholder and Change of Manager to Keyur Patel for their Retail Package Wine/Malt License

Representing Flamingo Market was attorney Ian Hedges. He explained that Ravi Patel and Rajiv Shah are selling their shares to Sunitaben Patel and Harikrishna Patel. He said Keyur Patel is the remaining sole shareholder. Mr. Hedges stated that Keyur Patel also owns another store in Andover and that he will be the manager at Attleboro Convenience. He added that Mr Patel is TIP certified.

Chairman Dave Wood asked what their carding policy is.

Keyur Patel said if it's a first-time customer, he will ask for identification. If they are known customers, he will not ask for identification.

Mr. Wood asked if Mr. Patel was familiar with the sting process.

Mr. Patel said he was.

Beth Borges from Bear Brewing said that they sell mead and cider at multiple farmers' markets.

Mr. Wood asked about the products being offered.

Ms. Borges said they produce pre-bottled dry meads and ciders with a 12% or 6% alcohol content. She explained that they use empty bottles for display at the farmers' markets. Ms. Borges stated that she and her coworker are both TIP certified. They ask for ID for 30 and under.

Mr. Wood asked when Bear Brewing was established.

Ms. Borges said in 2013. She said they are the most medaled farmer-winery in the area.

Tom Dion asked where the main office is located.

Ms. Borges said the winery is located in an industrial building in Newburyport, MA.
