Property Data Inspection Notice

The Assessors' Office is providing notice that property data inspections are being conducted throughout the City on a regular, ongoing basis. The data collectors are City employees who will carry City issued identification.

The Assessors are required by the Department of Revenue, Massachusetts General Law Chapter 58 Section 1 and 1A, to conduct a periodic data inspection program of each parcel at least once every ten (10) years to ensure that our property data, which forms the basis of your tax assessment, is correct and will result in full and fair cash value. No inspector will enter a home uninvited, or when there is not an adult resident at least 18 years old present. Also, due to COVID-19, procedures have been implemented to ensure the safety of all residents. Inspectors will knock, place a hanger on the door with information for you to contact us, and step back six feet to follow social distancing protocol. A property owner can refuse entry, but should be aware that incorrect data can negatively affect their assessment.

A property inspection includes an interior verification of data such as bedroom and bathroom counts, physical quality of construction (grade) and current condition, as well as an exterior measurement to verify square footage of living space and additional improvements such as garages, sheds, pools, and barns.

The Board of Assessor thank you for your cooperation. We understand there may be some inconvenience involved, and we appreciate your support and assistance.
