1. Approval of Meeting Minutes- October 19, 2023
2. Old Business:
  - a. For Study/Recommendation: Request to reduce the signed speed limit on South Ave. heading eastbound from South Ave. to the start of the state layout for Rte 95. Currently there is a sign at Tiffany Street/South Ave. intersection that indicates speed limit of 50 mph for the short stretch of road from Tiffany St. heading toward 95. There are several homes along this stretch just before the state layout for 95. Several calls have been made by the residents in these homes expressing fear turning into or out of their driveways as cars approach at this high rate of speed. Additionally, this has been the sight of numerous accidents, and affects the safe egress from Green Drive on to South Ave. (eastbound). The speed limit on the opposite side of the highway stretch is 40 mph and the speed limit prior to Tiffany St. is also lower.  
**Motion:** Lt Miller will speak with the Chief of Police for his input on speed limits in the area.

b. Request for speed limit signs for the following roads: Todd Dr., County St. heading toward Reed St. Currently, these streets have no posted speed limit signs. County St. .Did have a sign, which a resident indicated was removed during construction of new homes and was never replaced. Todd St. has seen an increase in drivers not from the area to access Luther Reservoir. Many of these drivers regularly exceed reasonable speed limits for this quiet residential road. DPW has since installed the missing signs on County St. Todd Dr. did not have signage.

**Motion:** was for APD to monitor the area to check for speeding.

c. Request for improved crosswalk signage on Locust St. at Hickory. There are about a dozen children who cross here for school, current signage coming around the corner on Locust is not sufficient. Several parents have called with concerns that. Cars are not stopping or slowing down when approaching the cross walk.

**Motion:** to recommend installation of high visibility signage at crosswalks and installation of sidewalks on Locust St. from Marlise Dr. to Standish Dr. on opposite side without sidewalks.

d. A resident of South Attleboro, Mary Campbell, reached out with concerns about speeding on Mendon Road and the safety of kids walking to Coelho MS. Here address is 222 Mendon Road. APD has patrolled the area at various

times and dates, did not find speeding to be egregious. More information to be gathered for the next meeting on possible sidewalk installation already being considered by the city.

e. A resident of Commonwealth Ave., Kim Lipman, is requesting a stop sign on Norgate Rd at Commonwealth Ave. This issue was voted in favor of recommending a stop sign at this intersection by the TSC during the October meeting. I am adding this item to the agenda as one of the residents in this area is asking a temporary stop sign pending review by the City Council on Dec. 5.
