## **Project Updates**

- 1. Renaissance South
  - Update presented by M. Crugnale, J. Jacobi
    - The project is now a 130 unit project with 1 commercial space on the South Main St end, with common space for tenants on the Wall St side
    - o It will be at grade on the South Main side, above grade with columns on the Riverfront Dr side -- similar to Renaissance North with parking underneath
    - o M. Crugnale stated that financing and partners are in place, looking to close on the property in September.
    - o Parking includes 1 space per bedroom (162 spaces in plan). Will be looking for variance on the size and number of parking spots
    - o Looking for input on the streetscape
  - Comments/Questions
    - o P. Danisi stated that the building should be a gateway to the TOD
    - o Needs more landscaping, rather than going right to the sidewalk

- Consider moving building back 10 feet from Wall St to give space for landscaping
- Could Riverfront Dr corner be ocracked and rotatedö/angled differently? M.
  Crugnale will discuss with engineers and architect
- All four sides of the building should be considered offrontso from a façade point of view
- Per M. Crugnale é no intent to change the exterior from what was approve in the larger original project
- o Mechanicals will be roof top and behind blinds
- Conceptual plans/elevations should be ready by April 15
- Joint meeting planned for Tuesday, April 16
