City of Attleboro
Community Electricity Aggregation (CEA) Program



The Attleboro CEA is the city's program to provide competitive choice for electricity to our residents and businesses.

The Attleboro CEA program is part of a 25-community electricity purchasing group, active since January 2016, and we thank you for your participation.

Attleboro CEA is changing electricity suppliers from Public Power to Constellation starting January 2021. You will see a notice in your January 2021 National Grid electricity bill.

You do not need to take any action to remain in the program on the default rate.

The new default program rate is \$0.10470 per kilowatt hour (kWh) fixed for 35 months (January 2021 through December 2023). This is 16% lower than National Grid's 2020-21 winter Basic Service Supply rate for residential customers. However, future savings compared to National Grid's rates cannot be guaranteed because National Grid's Basic Service rate for residential customers is fixed only for six months through April 2021.

Starting in 2021, Attleboro CEA will also offer two optional electricity rates with more renewable electricity than required by state law.

Utility Bill Notification

In January, you will see a notice on your National Grid bill that you have changed suppliers. In February, you will see the new program rate on your bill for the electricity you used in January. Attleboro residents and businesses in the program receive the default rate, which meets state renewable electricity standards, unless they affirmatively select one of our optional rates: 50% Local Green or 100% Local Green.

No action is needed to remain in the program on the default rate.

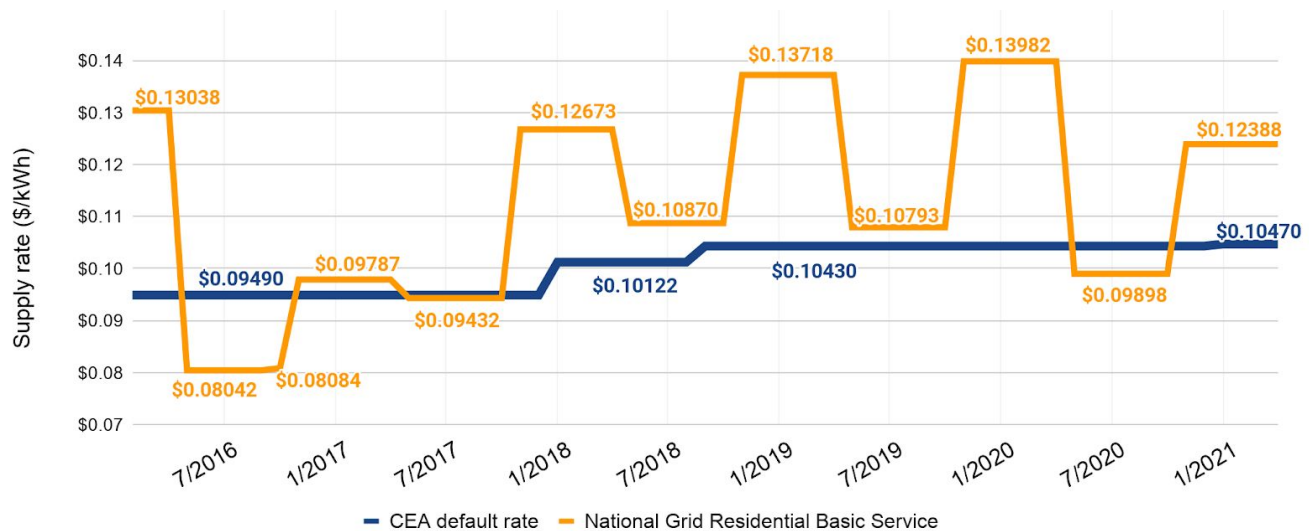
