RE: Bishop Street/Peckham Street paving

Dear Resident,

The City of Attleboro will be applying the surface coat of asphalt to Bishop Street and Peckham Street beginning this Friday. We apologize for the short notice, but the extreme weather changes this time of year have created a scheduling nightmare, to have this much needed work performed. The work is scheduled to be performed, during the daytime hours of 7:00am to 4:00pm. While this work is completed, the street will be closed to through traffic, but open to local traffic, school buses, mail carriers and emergency services. We ask that you please not park on the street and help us observe the construction zone, so that we can efficiently conduct the work and minimize impacts to everyone.

The resurfacing work will begin on Peckham Street and work inbound towards Park Street, for proper trucking measures. As noted in Mayor Heroux's previous letters to the affected residents, this resurfacing work is being undertaken, to provide a pothole free surface on both of these roadways for the immediate future. A full roadway reconstruction (milling, resetting roadway structures, final paving) will occur after the new water main is installed later next year.

We ask that you please make arrangements for this time frame. Please accept our advance apologies for any inconvenience caused. Your patience is very much appreciated.
